## ***Installation***

### **Your System**

To install and run this program, your system will need the following:

- Microsoft Windows XP, Windows Vista, or Windows 7/8.
- Administrative privileges on the system.
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 or higher.
- Super VGA monitor with a screen resolution set to at least 1024 x 758, small fonts.
- 1GB of RAM.

### **Installation Notes**

**Reboot** — If Windows prompts you to reboot your system, do so or LabelEase may not run properly.

**Uninstalling the program** — Select LabelEase from the Windows Control Panel Add/Remove Programs feature.

## ***Getting Started with LabelEase***

### **Starting a new Label:**

- Open LabelEase
- On the LabelEase Projects screen select the label you wish to start by selecting the appropriate label icon on the Annunciator or Panel Module tab.
- Double-click on the selected label icon or select "Open" to start the new label.

### **Editing Text Boxes:**

Most labels have editable text areas in which custom text can be added to labels. There are two ways to edit these text areas:

- 1) Double-Click on a text area to bring up the "Edit Text" dialog box.
- 2) Select a text area then from the program menu select Format -> Text -> Content. This will also bring up the "Edit Text" dialog box.

Add custom text to the "Edit Text" dialog box. Text formatting such as font, color, and text size can all be adjusted inside the "Edit Text" dialog box.

### **Adding Graphics:**

There are several ways to add graphics to labels. To add graphics to a label:

- 1) Drag and drop graphics from the included graphic library onto labels. These graphics are located in the left hand column of the program
- 2) Custom graphics can be added to labels by selecting Insert -> Picture from the program menu.

### **Adding new Shapes:**

New shapes can be added to labels to better customize them. From the program toolbar you are able to select from rectangles, ellipses, lines, arcs and freeform design. Text can be added to all rectangle and ellipse shapes as well as shading and color.
